NEWLY ENROLLED STUDENTS ON CAMPUS

The School of Biblical Studies, Jos, admitted a total of 31 new students (21 male and 10 female) for the 2024/2025 academic session. Out of the total enrollment this year, twenty-two (22) were admitted into the Diploma and Degree Programs and nine (9) were admitted into the Certificate Program. The newly admitted students came from 12 different states within Nigeria with two international students from the Chad Republic and Cameroon. The different states within the country are: Plateau (9 students), Nasarawa (1 student), Benue (6 students), Kaduna (1



student), Bauchi (3 students), Adamawa (1 student), Imo (1 student), Akwa Ibom (1 student), Delta (2 students), Enugu (2 students), Abia (1 student) and Ebonyi (1 student).

MESSAGES FROM BROTHER WORLEY

Our lawyer, a member of the church, contacted the Corporate Affairs Commission in Abuja to conduct a search for the name, SonLight University. We have received permission to name our future University with that name. Now we need to make our application to the Nigerian University Commission to begin the three-year registration process.

We have completed the registration of our medical clinic. After extensive interviews we have hired three nurses to begin the operation of our medical clinic. We hope to schedule doctors to visit as needed. Please pray for this much needed project.

Dr. Tom Udo Tom and Dr. James Ikwulono have been visiting with us since early September. Tom has visited with 17 congregations in 6 states while James has visited with 15 congregations in 7 states. They are scheduled to return to Nigeria on October 29. I hope many of you have enjoyed visiting with these good men. Let's pray for their safe return home.

With the recent storms devastating our southeastern states, thus requiring us as Christians, to help in every way possible, we have decided to move our appeal for your fifth Sunday contribution to March 30, 2025, to help us pay for the land for our permanent site of our SonLight University. We hope you will decide to include us in your budget for next year.

Lord willing, I plan to travel to Nigeria for one month in November. Please keep us in your prayers.

MASTER'S IN MINISTY AND NEW TESTAMENT PROGRAM

Our Master's Program at SBS consists of both classroom and on-line Bible and ministry courses. Many of our students prefer our on-line courses because they are preaching full-time for their congregations. The program requires a total of three semesters and seven teachers. Each student is required to pay a fee of two hundred dollars for their 18 months of classes.

Our first class began in August, 2022, with four students, graduates of SBS. Two of the students were Nigerian, one was Chadian, and one was from Cameroun. The Nigerian students and the Chadian student completed the eighteen-month course of study and graduated in May of 2024.

We presently have eighteen (18) students enrolled in the M.A. Ministry Program, with eight students scheduled to finish their course of study in December, 2024. They hope to graduate during our graduation ceremony in May, 2025. We plan to enroll additional students in January of 2025. Scholarships for this program are now available.
